Fed up with Riley model exclusivity practiced by two of the three major Riley clubs or would like to attend events in Scotland which are run for all Rileys, regardless of period/model?

If you answer "Yes" to any of these questions, you should consider joining Scottish Riley Enthusiasts, the Club founded in 1992 to promote the enjoyment of your Riley in Scotland. You do not need to be a Scot, nor to live in Scotland. You do not even need to own a Riley Car, and if you do, it does not matter which model, nor its condition.

SRE provides the following Member benefits:-

- Monthly Newsletter with Advertisements for cars and parts for sale and wanted (Free to members), Editorial comment, Area Reports and member contributions such as Trip reports and How to Do it technical articles, Announcements of forthcoming events, plus occasional Colour supplements. This publication can be taken in the form of hard copy by post or as an E-mailed Adobe document with Pictures in full colour.

- Annual Scottish National Riley Weekend at Whitsuntide, held in a different Scottish location each year and organised in turn by one of the five Areas that make up SRE. The event sets out to provide a pleasant and enjoyable stay in a good class hotel, a group dinner on the Saturday evening, runs to nearby beauty spots or sites of interest, and above all the opportunity to see fine Riley cars and to meet their owners. There are also trophies for various achievements awarded by the organising Committee, such as longest drive Distance to attend, plus those for concours, which are not judged, but polled among those attending.

- Monthly Area meetings at Roslin, Newhouse, Doune, Invergowrie and Kintore where you can meet with the local members to air views about the cars, share experiences, and seek advice and assistance with your car problems, be they car set-up matters, repairs, services available or loan of parts or tools. If you have no such problems, then come along simply to enjoy the company of like-minded people. The meetings are held in pubs, but you do not have to drink alcohol
- Locally organised events such as picnics, treasure hunts, navigational rallies, and sporting type exercise for your cars and yourself.

- Most SRE Areas support pet annual events organised by local communities or charities. This lets the public see the cars, and can sometimes recruit members and reveal history of and provenance of the cars.
